13:20-16:30	Guided Tour - We'll take you to Hsiangshan Matsu temple, Hsiangshan station and Hsiang Shan wetlands. Hsiangshan Railway Station was built in 1928 and it is the only cypress tree station left in Taiwan. It was built in the typical "Irimoya" architecture. When coming here, you can feel the relaxed and tranquil atmosphere. Hsiangshan Wetland is the largest wetland in northern Taiwan and it is the most attractive ecological scene in Hsinchu. In this place, you can enjoy the experience of shell gathering, net fishing, and oyster picking. Furthermore, the oyster field here has a history of more than 100 years, also a spectacular scene in this area.
