



# EZ Work Taiwan



## What is EZ Work Taiwan?

---

EZ Work Taiwan is an official platform by Taiwan's Ministry of Labor. It provides clear, reliable, and up-to-date information for foreigners who want to work in Taiwan, covering work permits, regulations, and more.

## 1. Can I Work in Taiwan?

---

Yes, if you:

- Have a professional job offer with a minimum monthly salary of NT\$47,971.
- Are an overseas graduate of a Taiwanese university with 70+ points in the work eligibility system.

## 2. How Do I Apply for a Work Permit?

---

- Step 1: Employer submits an online application on your behalf.
- Step 2: Wait for approval (7 working days if everything is complete).

## 3. How Long Is the Permit Valid?

---

- Standard duration: Up to 3 years.
- Extensions: Allowed. Specific professionals can apply for permits up to 5 years.

# Achieve More with the Taiwan Employment Gold Card



## ➔ WHAT IS THE TAIWAN EMPLOYMENT GOLD CARD?

The Gold Card is a 4-in-1 visa that combines:

1. Work Permit: No employer sponsorship required; you can freely work in Taiwan.
2. Resident Visa: Stay in Taiwan for up to 3 years.
3. Alien Resident Certificate (ARC): Simplifies living in Taiwan.
4. Re-Entry Permit: Unlimited travel in and out of Taiwan.

## ➔ WHO CAN APPLY?

To apply for the Taiwan Employment Gold Card, you must select a field of expertise. Each field has specific qualification criteria and subcategories (some fields do not have subcategories). The required supporting documents will vary based on the field of expertise you choose.

To check which field you may qualify for, use the **Gold Card Qualification Check** tool for guidance and tailored recommendations.

## ➔ HOW TO APPLY?

1. Online Application: Submit your documents and qualifications through the **Gold Card Portal**.
2. Approval Process: Applications are reviewed by relevant government agencies.
3. Receive Your Gold Card: Once approved, you'll get a physical card for easy travel and identification.
