1. Period

7 days from February 6 to February 12, 2023 (Return to home country on Feb. 13)

Decision to hold this Program will depend on the following:

- Participants can enter Japan with a tourist visa or a short-stay visa.
- No entry restrictions are in place due to COVID-19 infection status.

*The final decision will be announced by the end of December 2022. Even after the final decision, the program may be cancelled depending on circumstances.

2. Participation requirements

- Participants have completed the third round of COVID-19 vaccinations recognized as valid in Japan. (Influenza vaccination is optional but recommended.)
- Japanese LPT Level 3 or equivalent (can more or less understand everyday Japanese)

*The program is conducted in Japanese.

3. Number of Participants

- Please confirm the number of participants available of this e-mail.

4. Minimum number of participants

8 (Program may be cancelled if the number of applicants is less than the minimum)

5. Provided by CUC

• Accommodation, Lectures, Activities, Transportation costs for activities, Meals (except on weekends)

6. To be paid by the participant

- airfare, non-program meals, and free time activities
- Travel insurance, round-trip transportation from airport to accommodation

*If the program is cancelled, participants are responsible for cancellation fees for airline tickets, etc.

*If a participant is infected with COVID-19 or influenza during the program and needs to stay an extra night, he/she will be responsible for hotel charges.

7. Accommodations

- Participants will be accommodated in CUC dormitories during the program.
- One room per person is planned. (Contents subject to change)

8. Check-in and Check-out Date

- Please enter the Japan so that you can arrive at CUC by 16:00 on February 6.
- *If you cannot arrive at CUC by 16:00 on February 6, please come to Japan during February 5.
You will be responsible for your own accommodation expenses in that case. (In that case, you will be responsible for arranging your own accommodations.)
- Check-out date will be February 13.

9. Overseas travel insurance

All participants must buy their traveler's insurance which covers the duration of the trip, from the departure date to the date of return to their home country. CUC will ask participants to submit the PDF files of their insurance copy before the start of the program.
